

Hold'em On The Come Errata List

Almost any poker book carries some big or minor mistakes that are noticed only after publication – and unfortunately, ours is no exception. The “*Hold'em On The Come Study Group*” in my home country The Netherlands (part of the site www.pokerinfo.nl) has analyzed the book into depth, and found the following mistakes that I will share here with you here.

Please note that this errata list will usually mention only clear mistakes / flagrant errors rather than things that are open to interpretation. I will try to update this list for you on a monthly basis. If any of you has spotted any errors that are not listed here, feel free to send them over to me, so I can include them in this list. This way, the information we provide to our readers will be as accurate as possible.

- **Page 34 – top**
The flop $K♥K♣8♥$ must be $K♥K♣3♥$ - or else the $8♥$ would be duplicated.
- **Page 48 – top**
Here, we state: “There are, in fact, three times as many nut straight possibilities with the $9♣8♣$ as there are with the $9♣7♣$. (Only 8-6-5 makes a nut straight for the latter.)” This is not correct. A flop T-8-6 would make a nut straight as well, making it just 1.5 times as likely. (Thanks to RuterKnekt for spotting this one.)
- **Page 50 – bottom**
“All it does is give everybody else a better chance of making the same straight” needs the addition “- or possibly even a better one”.
- **Page 53 – halfway**
“Any seven or **queen**” should be “Any seven or **ten**”
- **Page 57 – halfway**
“Drawing to two... three-out hand at **worse**” should be **worst**
- **Page 73 – one thirds**
“I sure wouldn't... if I held $A♠4♠$ or $9♠8♠$ ”. This $8♠$ must be the $T♠$ -, or else it would be duplicated ($8♠$ is on the board already).
- **Page 88 – top**
“Note that against two opponents, there is a 49% chance that neither of them holds spades.” This 49% should be 39%. (Thanks to Nils Haugland for spotting this.)
- **Page 98 – bottom**
Last sentence: “Will your raise on the **turn**” should be **flop**
- **Page 117 – table action chart**
Table says 9.75:1, but that should be 7.25:1 (in line with the text on p. 118)
- **Page 119 – two thirds**
“This anomaly happens anytime you have to pay as much **or more** to stay in the hand...”
- **Page 122 & 216 – table action charts**
Table charts should be two piles of three bets – not three piles of two bets
- **Page 144 – second table action chart**
9:1 = 4.6 outs, not the 5.1 outs that is mentioned
- **Page 214 – two thirds**
“A set has ten outs to improve to a full **or quads**”.

- **Page 217 – bottom**
“if there is no pre-flop reraise” should be “if there is no **flop** reraise”.
- **Page 221 – table action chart**
“Turn: 18 bets, 4.5:1 (8.4 outs)” should be “Turn: 16 bets, 4:1 (9.2 outs)”, and this influences some of the wording below also.
